

## **OBJECTIVES OF SAN ANTONIO JUNIOR FORUM**

The objective of this organization is to create a greater interest among young women in Civic, Educational, and Philanthropic fields.

**CIVIC** – By taking an interest in affairs of the community. Service projects are designed to serve the needs of the community and its citizens.

**EDUCATIONAL** - By requiring new members to tour area facilities, researching and being knowledgeable of area needs.

**PHILANTHROPIC** - By studying the needs of the community so that the group will know where financial support is needed and then money raised through group projects can be donated.

Junior Forum chapters now exist in Austin, Baytown, Beaumont, Cypress-Woodlands, Dallas, Houston, Nacogdoches, Pasadena, Georgetown and San Antonio. Each group is a private, non-profit service and welfare organization composed of young women dedicated to community development, committed to keeping many areas of service available and involved with all age levels from infants to senior adults.

Many advantages are to be gained from being a member of a Junior Forum chapter, one of them being the privilege of transfer from one member club to another. There are six classes of members: Active, Prospective, Transitional, Inactive, Sustaining and Honorary Life.

In past years, well over \$1,000,000 has been raised and given to special causes by the women who serve in the ten Texas chapters of Junior Forum. Apart from raising money, these outstanding young women have donated over 200,000 hours of their time in community service. Junior Forum chapters, whose objectives, projects, membership, bylaws, and policies comply with the requirements of Junior Forum, Inc. are invited to affiliate. In addition to our plan of helping organize groups with the above aims, we are also interested in clubs already formed that might wish affiliation. The Admissions Committee will be glad to assist any group interested in additional information. Active and Prospective Membership is open to women 21 years or older who shall fulfill service and meeting attendance requirements and pay membership dues.
